

Identifying a TMS Candidate

TMS THERAPY MDD INDICATION

TMS therapy is indicated for adults with Major Depressive Disorder (MDD) that have failed 1 antidepressant of a high enough dose and duration.

TYPICAL INSURANCE CRITERIA*

- MDD** diagnosis
- 2 or more medication trials**
- Received evidence-based **talk therapy**

Who May Be A Candidate?

- Not satisfied with results of antidepressants
- Responded to medication, but not in remission
- Cannot tolerate medication side effects
- Has failed 1 or more medication trials
- Wishes to avoid antidepressants and/or augmentors
- Has MDD. Not FDA-cleared for Bipolar Depression, Schizoaffective Disorder, or Schizophrenia

Potential Contraindications

- Metallic implants in the head/neck (exception: braces & dental fillings)
- History of seizure disorder
- Implanted medical devices, like a pacemaker
